Students Satisfaction Survey (SSS) for the year 2020-21

Analysis Report

The survey from graduate students only has been conducted online during the period 27/09/2021 To 02/10/2021.

The report of it is analyzed and the following points came forward from the said analysis. Out of 339 students 152 students (Strength at TY classes for the year 2020-21). The percentage of responses is 44.83.

S S survey is in general on entire teaching-learning process and general administration. The questionnaire for SSS is bilingual as to understand the meaning of question and answer to it in a right way from the student.

The analysis is as below-

- Near about 54% female students and 46% male students have responded the survey.
- 16% students who are pursuing other than Bachelors' degree such as Master's, M Phil and other also participated in the survey.
- 25% student responses show coverage of syllabus less than 70%.
- 5% teachers prepare for the classes poorly.
- 3% teachers need to improve their teaching method and communication skills.
- Continuous internal evaluation process is always fair.
- The performance in the assignment is discussed usually and every time with the students.
- 33% students say that institute promotes internship, SEP and field visit opportunities for them.
- The teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitates cognitive, social and emotional growth of students through multiple opportunities.
- Mentoring process is carried out with timely follow up of assigned work.
- Almost all 92% teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.
- Teacher identify students weaknesses and strengths, and encourage them to overcome and for challenge.
- Efforts are made by the college to engage students for improving quality of teaching learning process through monitoration and review continuously.
- The college use student centric methods to enhance learning experiences.

- The students are strongly encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities.
- The institute makes sufficient efforts to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills among the students.
- Almost 95% of teachers use ICT tools in teaching learning process.
- The overall quality of teaching learning process in the institute is very good.
- Through the suggestions it seems that the students expect more efforts for online education, support to them along with timely follow up of the task assigned to them from the college.

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Action Taken Report

- The analysis report of SSS was place before the CDC and IQAC meetings.
 - Coverage of syllabus is less than 70% : This issue was discussed and came to a conclusion that large number of students are not able to attend the online lectures/classes due to the technical difficulties such as no internet connectivity, weak internet connectivity, and no Wi-Fi facility, do not have android mobile phones, financial issues, etc.
 - Few teachers prepare classes poorly: In general all the teachers are motivated and encouraged for the improvement in the class preparation but there is no system as such for attainment of improvement.
 - To improve the teaching methods and communication skills, college should plan for the training programs.
 - To promote internship, Student Exchange Program, field visit and etc. activities for the students IQAC should prepare the plan and execute it properly along with the feedback.
 - As per the survey, for the expectations students, the authorities should make a plan to enhance online quality teaching, give support to the students as per their needs and should continually take the follow up of task assigned to them.

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
